

A Gondola Gig

If you have ever gone to Italy and enjoyed a gondola ride in Venice – or done so from the day dreams of your easy chair – we discovered a day event that will let you live it for real.

Gig Harbor Gondola is the result of an American in love with Venice. John Synco thought that the small harbor provided just the right spot for rowing. John purchased the gondola from friends in California that had imported it from Venice and resold it to him.

The trips in the gondola are 60 or 90 minutes. They include a nice snack box from the Gig Harbor General Store that contains cheeses, crackers, olives, sausage and grapes. Guests can bring the beverage of their choice – we brought cans of bubbly from Coppola wines as our boating wine of choice that comes with straws.

As you are rowed around the Harbor your gondolier sings for you, provides history about the Harbor and some of the buildings along the way. The views are



spectacular of Mt. Rainier and local wildlife. Make your reservations to pick days with the best weather. We received our event as a gift and I would suggest it as a perfect gift as events do not require a particular size and offer no clutter to the recipient. Gig Harbor Gondola (.com) 253-432-0052 runs all year long and decorates their gondola for holiday cruises.

Gig Harbor has a nicely compact downtown with plenty of all day parking especially if you come



during the week for your event. There is a nice city park right on the water less than a block from the marina and with clean public restrooms. We enjoyed taking an easy walk around the downtown shops while waiting for our gondola to launch. One shop – For the Love of Spice – has olive oil and wine tasting, along with a full range of spice selections from simple spuntino to full meal cooking. The owner, Windy Payne, is very knowledgeable about Italy from her own travels.

Before returning to Seattle we wanted to keep the Italian flavor of the day date and enjoyed dinner at Massimo Italian Bar and Grill on Purdy Drive. The restaurant is located just a few feet above sea level giving us a great view of the harbor to finish our gondola day.

2018-19 Scholarship Application

The Italian Club of Seattle is awarding up to two individual \$500.00 scholarships. The scholarships for the 2018-2019 school year will be awarded to students who are selected based on meeting or exceeding the scholarship criteria (noted below). As in years' past; the better the GPA, the better chance of a scholarship award.

Next steps in the scholarship process:

- April 2018 Application submission window opens
- May 2018 Application submission window closes, application verification
- June 2018 Award Recipients determined, all applicants notified of their status
- September 2018 Award Recipients published in the *il Ficcanaso* and presented at the General Meeting
- October 2018 Scholarship payments made to the schools on behalf of the recipients

The qualifications each recipient needs to meet or exceed are:

- 1. A parent of the applicant (student) must be in good standing in the Italian Club for at least three years. (Grandparents are not included).
- 2. The parent(s) of the applicant must attend at least three club meetings during the year.
- 3. The applicant (student) is or will be enrolled in high school (grades 9 through 12) for the 2018-2019 school year, in the greater Seattle area.
- 4. The applicant (student) must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher (with official transcript) and take part in extra-curricular activities, community service, etc.
- 5. Each applicant must write a letter telling about themselves and activities in which he/she is participating.
- 6. The application and transcript must be post marked no earlier than April 15th, 2018 and no later than May 10th, 2018.
- 7. Applications that are incomplete or missing a transcript will not be considered.
