The scholarship for the 2021-2022 school year will be awarded to the student who is selected based on meeting or exceeding the scholarship qualifications (noted below). Next steps in the scholarship process:

2021-2022 Scholarship Application

- June 1, 2021 Application submission window opens.
- June 30, 2021 Application submission window closes, application verification.
- July 2021 Award Recipient determined, all applicants notified of their status.
- September 2021 Award Recipient published in the *il Ficcanaso* and presented at the General Meeting.
- October 2021 Scholarship payment made to the school on behalf of the recipient.
