Rhys Bowen has outdone herself this time. *The Tuscan Child* is set in two different time periods that are linked together masterfully; her current life and that of her just deceased father set in WWII.

A young British woman has received notice that her father has died. She has not stayed in touch with him as the two were never very close. Joanna must go home to take care of his estate. Their family has an aristocratic history and for the past four hundred years has been the owner of a significant property. However, she arrives in a time after he as already lost the property due to debt and became a teacher to the school that now occupies it.

In reviewing things hidden in his personal items, she discovers details of his life that were never passed on to

We hope you have a good Lenton season. Happy St. Patrick's Day to all those who might be a wee bit Irish as well as to those of us who are not.



her. As a pilot for Royal Air Force during WWII he was shot down in a remote area of Tuscany, controlled by the German Army. He was seriously injured and forced to take cover in a bombed-out structure for a considerable period of time. Among his things was an unopened letter, to a woman he obviously fell in love with, and with references to their child.

Joanna's life has already been fraught with her own emotional disasters before learning of her father's death. In order to leave some of her own past behind she drops everything and heads off to Italy to unravel yet the rest of her family history. In the process she learns a lot about herself and a culture she never previously knew.

The mystery, murder and stress it brings to her is an emotional rollercoaster made up of easy reading and good character development.

2020-2021 Scholarship Application

The Italian Club of Seattle is awarding a single \$1,000.00 dollar scholarship. The scholarship for the 2020-2021 school year will be awarded to the student who is selected based on meeting or exceeding the scholarship qualifications (noted below). As in years past; the better the GPA, the better chance of a scholarship award.

Next steps in the scholarship process:

- April 1, 2020 Application submission window opens.
- May 31, 2020 Application submission window closes, application verification.
- June 2020 Award Recipient determined, all applicants notified of their status.
- September 2020 Award Recipient published in the *il Ficcanaso* and presented at the General Meeting.
- October 2020 Scholarship payment made to the school on behalf of the recipient.

The qualifications the recipient needs to meet or exceed are:

- 1. Parents must be in good standing for three years.
- 2. G.P.A must be 3.0 or above.
- 3. Scholarship is paid specifically for tuition, directly to a state accredited High School the recipient attends.
- 4. The scholarship amount is \$1,000.00.
- 5. The scholarship is applied only for the regular school years 9-12.


