#### Peter Orville Della Vedova, ICoS 9th President

#### 1974 Interview by Dennis Caldirola



Like Andy DiGeria, president of the Italian Club before him, our ninth president, Peter Orville Della Vedova, was born in the province of Udine and spent most of his boyhood years there. Specifically, Pete entered the world September 29, 1896 in the town of Navarons near the Swiss-Italian bor-

der, and at the age of eleven, immigrated to the United States with his family. Pete's father had been a miner and to continue to pursue his trade he settled the Della Vedova family in Red Lodge, Montana. In this rather humble environment, Pete embarked upon the course of scholastic activity which was to result in his graduation from Harvard Law School in 1924. That year was an important one for him, for Pete decided to make Seattle his home and, in December he married Anne Baxter, a Red Lodge girl of Scottish descent, in Portland, Oregon. At approximately the same time, Pete let his name be shortened to the distinctive P.O.D. Vedova, went to work for Equitable Securities in the Henry Building, and joined the Italian Commercial Club.

It was not long before Pete had established himself enough to open a practice of his own. In 1926 he took an office in the Central Building where he remained nearly all of his professional career. As president in 1932, Pete saw the amalgamation of the Italian Commercial Club and the Atlantic St. Athletic Club. Some two decades later he was to spearhead an action which had benefits still realized today: the lawsuit against the operators of the Italian (Gambling) Club which was settled out of court for approximately 1/4 million dollars.

Pete remained active in the organization until his retirement from practice in 1962. Today he and Anne commute between their two homes: winter in Palm Springs, summer at their 20 acre estate out near Bothell. Their daughter, Jemma Jean, is now Mrs. John Cogan and has three lovely children (two of whom are pictured above). Pete remembers the Italian Club tondly and will continue to follow our activities via the *il Ficcanaso*.

### August Joseph Ghiglione, ICoS 10th President 1974 Interview by Dennis Caldirola



The tenth president of the Italian Club in the organization's 13th term of office, was the esteemed doctor, A.J. Ghiglione. He was born August Joseph in New Nork City, August 16, 1884, and culminated his scholastic activities by obtaining a degree in Medicine from Columbia University. In 1904, during his residency at Columbia-Lying Hospital, he married the former Estell Skinner and in 1905 they migrated west to Seattle

where the Doctor's father, Angelo, and his two brothers, Frank and Charley, were already living. Dr. Ghiglione went immediately into general practice but shortly thereafter was appointed Acting Italian Consul for the Pacific, a position he held until 1914.

During this time he and his wife added three children to their family, Maybelle, Angelo and August, and as an active member of the Italian community, the Doctor became a charter member of the Italian Commercial Club when it was founded in 1919. Then in 1921, tragedy struck the Ghiglione household when Estell passed away. The Doctor carried on with his work, now located mostly in the Stimpson Building at 4th Avenue and Pike Street, and in 1924 was appointed Chief of Staff at Providence Hospital, a position he was to hold several times. In 1924 he married Birdie, nee Chamberlain, and she became a member of the Ladies Auxiliary. Upon being elected in 1933, the Doctor oversaw the continuing unification of the various Italian organizations in their relatively new home, The Casa. In 1939 he served as Chief of Staff at Columbus Hospital and after taking ill in 1943, finally retired from practice in 1946.

Dr. Ghiglione passed away in August of 1949 and was survived by Birdie (now Mrs. Birdie Hamilton) and their son John. Those that knew him remember his passing not only as a great personal loss but also as a loss to the whole community.
