 - 3. The applicant (student) must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher (with official transcript) and take part in extra-curricular activities, community service, etc.
- 4. Each applicant must write a letter telling about him/her self and activities in which he/she is participating.
- 5. The application and transcript must be post marked no earlier than April 1st 2010 and no later than May 1st 2010.
- 6. Applications that are incomplete or missing a transcript will not be considered.


