The Italian Club of Seattle is awarding up to three individual \$500.00 scholarships. The scholarships for the 2012-2013 school year will be awarded to students who are selected based on meeting or exceeding the scholarship criteria (noted below). As in years' past; the better the GPA, the better chance of scholarship award.

The qualifications each recipient needs to meet or exceed are:

- A parent of the applicant (student) must be in good standing in the Italian Club for at least three years.
 (Grandparents are not included).
- The parent(s) of the applicant must attend at least three club meetings during the year.
- 3. The applicant (student) is enrolled in high school (grades 9 through 12) for the 2012 -2013 school year, in the greater Seattle area
- The applicant (student) must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher (with official transcript) and take part in extracurricular activities,

are endless and to have close friends to collaborate and challenge your decisions is really great and amusing. I guess many Italian think they can cook, sing and act. It really helps my confidence to have feedback and assurance that I am on the right track. Eating great food is a wonderful thing preparing food and cooking with friends is divine. I want to personally thank: Paul Case, Rich Hall, Greg Pirolo, Greg Pesce, Bob Sylvester, Al Carlson, Glen Suggs, Marty Nigrelle, Dot Whitney, and Dick Whitney. This team continually improves and delivers a great plate of pasta, salad and crab to two hundred and twenty five people very quickly.

Many requests came in for the pasta recipe and we will publish it again with a few secrets. First I found that by heating extra virgin olive oil with the red pepper flakes adds a toasty flavor. I strain out the seeds and flakes and am left with an infusion of red oil that I mix back into the sauce. It is potent and you can refrigerate this red pepper oil infusion to add a kick to many different dishes. To get the moist pasta add liberal amounts of the pasta cooking water into your pasta mix. The starch of the pasta water will emulsify with the lipids and will coat your pasta with creamy goodness.

I am really enjoying the monthly meetings and we are spending most of our time visiting, eating and enjoying each other's company. Keeping our focus on the fun factor will keep people coming and bringing their friends. We have several people inquiring about membership and now have an interactive application on the web site. This means you can go to the Italian Club of Seattle web site, click on application and type all your information, and then print and sign and you're done. Thanks to new member Joe Jacobin for helping us with the interactive form.

AGLIO Y OLIO Y PEPPERINCHINO SAUCE RECIPE

- 1 lb. pasta (uncooked)
- 3 teaspoons salt
- ½ cup reserved pasta water
- 7 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil divided
- ½ stick of butter
- 4 tablespoons fresh minced garlic, divided
- 1 teaspoon dried red pepper flakes
- 1 ounce anchovies canned
- 2 tablespoons of capers
- 10 chopped Kalamata olives
- 1/4 cup chopped parsley
- 2 teaspoons fresh lemon juice
- ½ cup grated Parmesan cheese
- ½ cup of bread crumbs
- Salt and black pepper

- Melt olive oil, butter and garlic (finely pressed or chopped), cook slowly so as not to burn the garlic.
- Add anchovies, salt and pepper (Lightly) leave on low heat while pasta cooks.
- Cook pasta al dente reserving some starchy water for sauce. (10-11 minutes)
- Drain and place in bowl, add sauce and lemon juice and reserved pasta water and toss
- Plate and spread Parmesan cheese, olives, capers, bread crumbs and


