Mama Romano's Baked Lemon Chicken

As submitted by Judy Lewis

8 Chicken Breasts

1 t. kosher salt

1/4 t. freshly ground black pepper flour for dredging

Olive oil

3 cups thinly sliced onions

1 1/2 T. thinly sliced garlic

8 fresh thyme sprigs

1 ½ cups chicken stock

2 lemons

In olive oil, caramelize sliced onions with the garlic and some fresh thyme, a little salt and pepper and cover the bottom of the casserole dish with the onion mixture.

Season the chicken breasts with salt and pepper. Dredge in flour.

Preheat oven to 325 degrees.

In a 10-inch ovenproof skillet, heat a few tablespoons of olive oil over medium heat. Sauté the chicken breasts to a rich golden brown. Transfer to a casserole dish and layer across length wise. Top with a few more thyme sprigs. Pour over ½ chicken stock. Slice lemons in thin rounds and place on top of each chicken breast.

Bake about 20-30 minutes.

The Italian Club of Seattle is awarding up to three individual \$500.00 scholarships. The scholarships for the 2014-2015 school year will be awarded to students who are selected based on meeting or exceeding the scholarship criteria (noted below). As in years' past; the better the GPA, the better chance of scholarship award.

Next steps in the scholarship process:

- May 2014 Application submission window closes, application verification
- June 2014 Award Recipients determined in the June board meeting, all applicants notified of their status
- September 2014 Award Recipients published in the il Ficcanaso and presented @ General Meeting
- October 2014 Scholarship payments made to the schools on behalf of the recipients

The qualifications each recipient needs to meet or exceed are:

- 1. A parent of the applicant (student) must be in good standing in the Italian Club for at least three years. (Grandparents are not included).
- 2. The parent(s) of the applicant must attend at least three club meetings during the year.
- 3. The applicant (student) is enrolled in high school (grades 9 through 12) for the 2014-2015 school year, in the greater Seattle area
- 4. The applicant (student) must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher (with official transcript) and take part in extracurricular activities, community service, etc.
- 5. Each applicant must write a letter telling about themselves and their extracurricular activities.
- The application and transcript must be post marked no earlier than April 10th, 2014 and no later than May 8th, 2014
- 7. Applications that are incomplete or missing a transcript will not be considered.


